Dean's Scholarship

How to Apply

The Northwest State Community College Presidential Scholarship is an \$8,000 renewable scholarship. The maximum amount of the scholarship is \$2,000 per semester, for four (4) consecutive fall and spring semesters. Fourteen (14) students will be offered the scholarship; two (2) eligible seniors from each county.

The Northwest State Community College Dean's Scholarship is a \$4,000 renewable scholarship. The maximum amount of the scholarship is \$1,000 per semester, for four (4) consecutive fall and spring semesters. Twenty-eight (28) students will be offered the scholarship; four (4) eligible seniors from each county.

Applications for the 2012-2013 Presidential and Dean's Scholarships must be submitted no later than April 1, 2012. Applications can be found in your high school guidance counselor's office or online at www.northweststate.edu/current_students. You will need to click on the "Financial Aid" and then "Scholarships" link where you will find a complete listing of scholarships available at NSCC.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Applicant must be a high school senior from Defiance, Fulton, Henry, Paulding, Putnam, Van Wert or Williams counties.
2. Applicant must be a May/June 2012 graduate with a seven (7) semester grade point average of 3.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale.
3. Applicant must earn a minimum ACT composite score of 23 and subscores of 18 in English, 21 in reading and 22 in math.
4. Applicants must submit a 150 word essay discussing their educational goals.
5. Applicant must complete an application for admission to NSCC and submit the appropriate application fee.
6. Applicant must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit a Student Aid Report (SAR) to the NSCC Financial Aid Office. The NSCC code is 008677.
7. Must be a U.S. citizen or legal resident.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Applicant must be a high school senior from Defiance, Fulton, Henry, Paulding, Putnam, Van Wert or Williams counties.
2. Applicant must be a May/June 2012 graduate with a seven (7) semester grade point average of 3.30 or higher on a 4.00 scale.
3. Applicant must earn minimum ACT subscores of 18 in English, 21 in reading and 22 in math.
4. Applicants must submit a 150 word essay discussing their educational goals.
5. Applicant must complete an application for admission to NSCC and submit the appropriate application fee.
6. Applicant must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit a Student Aid Report (SAR) to the NSCC Financial Aid Office. The NSCC code is 008677.
7. Must be a U.S. citizen or legal resident.

1. Complete the NSCC Presidential and Dean's Scholarship Application.
2. Submit your high school transcripts with your grade point average and ACT scores.
3. Submit the completed application and 150 word essay by April 1, 2012.
4. Recipients must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit a Student Aid Report (SAR) to the NSCC Financial Aid Office each year. The NSCC code is 008677.

Scholarship Use

The NSCC Presidential Scholarship will be applied to tuition, books and fees only after all other grants and scholarships are used. This scholarship will be awarded up to a maximum of \$2,000 per semester.

Scholarship Use

The NSCC Dean's Scholarship will be applied to tuition, books and fees only after all other grants and scholarships are used. This scholarship will be awarded up to a maximum of \$1,000 per semester.

To Renew the Scholarship

The Presidential Scholarship is renewable for four (4) consecutive fall and spring semesters when recipients meet the following criteria:

1. Presidential Scholarship recipients must maintain 15 credit hours or more each semester and maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0.
2. Recipients must complete 20 hours of community service each semester with a minimum of 10 hours to be completed on the NSCC campus. Recipients must meet each semester with the coordinator of the Presidential Scholarship to verify community service hours performed.
3. Recipients must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit a Student Aid Report (SAR) to the NSCC Financial Aid Office each year. The NSCC code is 008677.

To Renew the Scholarship

The Dean's Scholarship is renewable for four (4) consecutive fall and spring semesters when recipients meet the following criteria:

1. Dean's Scholarship recipients must maintain 15 credit hours or more each semester and maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0.
2. Recipients must complete 10 hours of community service each semester. A minimum of 5 hours must be completed on the NSCC campus each semester. Recipients must meet each semester with the coordinator of the Dean's Scholarship to verify community service hours performed.
3. Recipients must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit a Student Aid Report (SAR) to the NSCC Financial Aid Office each year. The NSCC code is 008677.

In the event that the total number of scholarships is not awarded, the College reserves the right to award additional scholarships to students who meet the eligibility criteria, regardless of their county of residence.
