Phlebotomy Technician Certificate

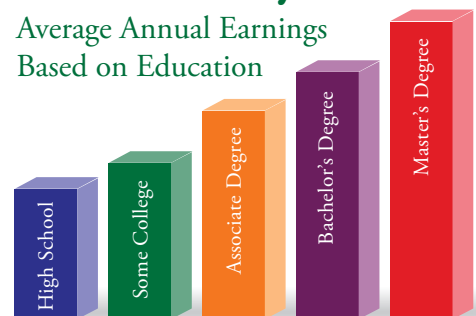
